Gain essential web development skills using DreamweaverMX 2004 (with a sneak preview of FireworksMX 2004). Students will build a basic site with an emphasis placed on the web design and the development process. Dreamweaver topics covered: the user interface, basics, linking, tables, layout, type, cascading style sheets, frames, roll-overs, and forms. Site control, web hosting and Fireworks integration will also be introduced.

AfterEffects® August 3-5

Instructor: Mike Stevens

The objective of this course is to develop skills in producing and editing video and sound for multimedia productions, emphasis is on the capture, editing and outputting of video using a desktop digital video workstation. This course will take students through the process of collecting raw video and audio footage, imaging and text compositing it into a final production using basic digital video editing, audio editing, video compositing and special effects. The student will learn the basics of editing as well as processing and compression for various outputs, such as: NTSC, Multimedia, and World Wide Web, with attention to the aesthetics and principles of design and composition. The software used will be primarily Adobe AfterEffects plus QuickTime. Course Outcome: Basic knowledge of the After Effects Interface.
